General Surface Preparation:

All areas must be sound, dry, free of oil, grease or dirt, and peeling point. New surfaces should be primed with our undercoat, wait 24 hours, and then apply the finish enamel.

For previous painted surfaces, dull glossy areas by light sanding and dust. Remove loose paint, prime bare areas with appropriate primer. Fill cracks with suitable filler and then brush with the required enamel.

Precaution and Safety:
